

MINUTES OF THE 62nd MEETING OF STATE LEVEL ENVIRONMENT IMPACT ASSESSMENT AUTHORITY (SEIAA) HELD ON 03rd September, 2019 AT PRANI SAMPAD BHAVAN

The sixty second meeting of the State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA) was held on 03rd September, 2019 in the Conference Room of Environment Department, Prani Sampad Bhavan, 5th Floor, LB – Block, Sector – III, Salt Lake, Kolkata – 700106. Following cases were discussed:

I. Discussion on

- a. Revamped web portal of MoEF&CC for appraisal of application for Environment Clearance.

Smt. Bhaswati Nandy, Master Trainer presented the salient features of PARIVESH portal. Discussions were held against each of the items and it is decided that all cases henceforth would be processed through this portal.

- b. MoEF&CC's OM dated 23rd August 2019 in connection with OA No. 837/2018 in the matter of Sandeep Mittal Vs UOI.

The matter was discussed. At present SEIAA does not have any manpower nor does have any sanctioned post. The SEIAA Secretariat does not have any dedicated office space nor any vehicle and other infrastructure. Thus, it is decided to recommend the following set of manpower for proper functioning of SEIAA and the monitoring of category 'B' projects as per MoEF&CC's OM dated 23rd August 2019 in connection with OA No. 837/2018 in NGT Principal Bench regarding the matter of Sandeep Mittal Vs UOI.




